Job Details

Montserrat Utilities Limited (MUL) is the sole utility provider (Water and Electricity) in Montserrat.

MUL was formed on 1st July 2008 with the merger of the then Montserrat Water Authority and Montserrat Electricity Services Limited.

The successful candidate will be responsible for directing and coordinating the implementation of corporate strategy for the water and electricity operations within the guidelines established by the Board of Directors; supervising the activities of the various department heads as well as establishing and maintaining effective relationships with key stakeholders.

Salary:

Commensurate with qualifications and experience

Requirements:

1. A Bachelor's Degree in Engineering, plus a minimum of ten (10) years' experience in a senior engineering or management position, preferably in a power generation or civil engineering environment.
2. A postgraduate Degree in Business Administration plus relevant training in supervisory management.
3. Good knowledge of the operations of a water and/or electric utility.



Responsibilities will include:

1. Reviewing, in consultation with the Board and staff, the overall strategy for the utilities, including the mission, objectives and targets.
2. Planning and directing preparation of the organization's corporate business plan and the annual budgets of the company and approving submission of estimates to the Board.
3. Assisting with the planning and implementation of major programmes of the utilities concerned with the acquisition of physical assets, expansion of services and major change initiatives, including recommending the release of funds and allocation of resources by the Board, and reviewing periodic progress reports of Managers.
4. Liaising with managers and monitoring the preparation of quarterly and annual reports on the operations of the utilities and arranging for submission of these reports to the Board. Advising and making recommendations to the Board where annual performance is expected to deviate substantially from agreed targets.
5. Continually reviewing and improving the cost effectiveness of the operations by assessing the performance of the utilities against best practice standards and determining appropriate corrective action.
6. Reviewing monthly reports from divisional managers to include technical status reports, accounting schedules, quarterly financial reports and workforce reports.
7. Evaluating the performance of the Management Team to ensure agreed performance targets and standards are being met.
8. Developing and maintaining an awareness of environmental changes that impinge on the utilities' policies and affect operations; analysing their impacts and making recommendations to the Board of Directors.
9. Spearhead initiatives for the introduction and development of renewable energy (e.g.: geothermal, solar and wind) as the major source of energy supplied.
10. Develop and implement a wastewater strategy for Montserrat.
11. Performing statutory responsibilities as a member of the Board of Directors.
